

SLA Adopts "No Soliciting" Resolution



The Sherwood Lake Association Board of Directors adopted a resolution with regard to solicitors in Lake Sherwood Acres.

RESOLUTION OF THE SHERWOOD LAKE ASSOCIATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Whereas, house-to-house peddling, as defined by the East Baton Rouge Parish Code of Ordinances, Section 12:200, is a nuisance, and

Whereas, such house-to-house peddling, is defined as trespassing by the East Baton Rouge Parish Code of Ordinances, Section 12:152, and

Whereas, the Sherwood Lake Association Board of Directors wishes to prohibit house-to-house peddling in Lake Sherwood Acres Subdivision, as allowed by the East Baton Rouge Parish Code of Ordinances, Section 12:200(b)(1)b,

Now therefore, the following resolution has been adopted by the Sherwood Lake Association Board of Directors.

Be it resolved, that the Sherwood Lake Association Board of Directors hereby designates Lake Sherwood Acres Subdivision as a no peddling area and prohibits house-to-house peddling and trespassing as defined by the East Baton Rouge Parish Code of Ordinances, Section 12:200 and Section 12:152 in Lake Sherwood Acres Subdivision.

This Resolution was duly adopted by unanimous vote of the Sherwood Lake Association Board of Directors at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 5, 2014.

As mentioned above, there is already a EBRCOP Ordinance, Title **12:200 - House-to-house peddling as nuisance** "The practice of going in and upon private residences in the city-parish, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, or itinerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise, not having been required or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of the private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares or merchandise, and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same, and/or for the purpose of sale of services. **Religious, political, or charitable solicitation is not considered to be peddling.**

(b)(1) Hours: House-to-house peddling shall be allowed between the hours of 9am-7pm with the following exceptions:

**A "NO SOLICITATION" sign has been posted at the residence in accordance with 12:152(a)(1)c; or by Resolution of the HOA which follows.

We have signs posted at 3 of our 4 entrances and we are getting one for LSE

If a solicitor is at your door, don't open the door if you feel uncomfortable or wary about the individual(s), it is better to be on the safe side. If someone pressures you, don't hesitate to call the police at 389-2000
