All of the fountains are working properly. The unit next adjacent to the zz property has been turned off to prevent intake clogging by debris coming with the recent rains. This unit will be turned on when the rain subsides.

Fall means cooler temperatures and trees shedding their leaves. Please bag as many as possible. Some will wind up in our lake, but every year I see lawn workers using blowers to push them into the street along with grass clippings or from back yards to blow them directly into the lake.. All of the storm drains on the lake side of our streets discharge into our lake. This adds to the siltation we are experiencing. Please do what you can to help us reduce this soil load.

Aerator Project:

The water depths continue to show improvements and the test will go into next year.

GOALS FOR 2016

1. Encourage Christmas decorations along the bulkheads and streets. **Cazes**
2. Reduce nuisance animal populations. (Ducks, beaver, and nutria). **Hicks & Cazes**
3. Sample lake water two times (July and Oct.). **Cazes.**
4. Evaluate effectiveness of the pilot aerator. **Cazes & Hayes. On-going.**
5. **Continue efforts to encourage residents to repair and/or install bulkheads. Cazes, Edwards, Hayes**
6. Continue contracting for lake cleaning. **Cazes. On-going.**
