We encourage bulkhead replacement or repair if needed. A properly working structure not only adds value to your property, but it keeps your yard from eroding into the lake.

A special note of Thanks to the property owners and or their lawn crews for attempts to bag or blow clippings and now leaves away from the storm drains which flow into our lake.

Please continue to clean up any trash that may be floating by your property.

GOALS FOR 2018

1. Encourage Christmas decorations along the bulkheads and streets. **Cazes**

3. Sample lake water two times (July and Oct.). **Cazes. (Delayed due to LSU test lab)**
4. Evaluate effectiveness of the pilot aerator. **Cazes & Hayes. On-going.**
5. **Continue efforts to encourage residents to repair and/or install bulkheads. Cazes, Edwards, Hayes**
6. Continue contracting for lake cleaning. **Cazes. On-going.**
7. Check into lake finger cleaning options.
