All five of our fountains are currently working properly. Some much-needed rain arrived with a cool front on the first weekend of November. The inch of rain brought the lake level up significantly, but the level is still several inches below the top of the dam.

We continue to encourage bulkhead replacement or repair if needed. A properly working structure not only adds value to your property, but it keeps your yard from eroding into the lake and makes it harder for the nutria to live there. **We now have an additional, more competitive contractor for bulkheads if you are thinking of replacing yours.
