All 5 of our fountains are working properly.

We encourage bulkhead replacement or repair if needed. A properly working structure not only adds value to your property, but it keeps your yard from eroding into the lake and makes it harder for the nutria to live there. We now have an additional, more competitive contractor for bulkheads if you are thinking of replacing yours. Please contact me at 225-229-5971.

Please inform your lawn crews that any trash blown into the storm drains goes directly into the lake with the first heavy rainfall!!

Be careful when applying lawn fertilizers, that they are not easily washed into the lake. City and University lakes are a prime example of algae bloom due to excessive fertilizer. This year we seem to have been spared a bad algae bloom again. Thanks to all.

Please continue to clean up any trash that may be floating by your property. Thank You to our neighbors who lend a hand at keeping our lake looking beautiful!
