**OCTOBER 2023**

**Fountain #3 had some electrical issues that were resolved by CCR. All five of our fountains are working properly.**

**The lake is about a foot low, exposing some bottom mud in areas that had shallow water prior to the extreme drought we have experienced. Despite being low the water conditions are still very good.**

**We continue to encourage bulkhead replacement or repair if needed. A properly working structure not only adds value to your property, but it keeps your yard from eroding into the lake and makes it harder for the nutria to live there. **We now have an additional, more competitive contractor for bulkheads if you are thinking of replacing yours. **Please inform your lawn crews that any trash blown into the storm drains goes directly into the lake with the first heavy rainfall!!**
