Fountain #4 next to the Retirement Village has had a new motor installed. All five of our fountains are currentlyworking properly. The lake is down almost a foot due to the rain free past month, but showers are anticipated later this week.

We encourage bulkhead replacement or repair if needed. A properly working structure not only adds value to your property, but it keeps your yard from eroding into the lake and makes it harder for the nutria to live there.
